



## An off-beat day to rural Salay

### Bagan

**Adventure off-beat trip to Salay by 1.5hours drive from Bagan to discover the historic monuments with a local picnic lunch served at monastery**

1.5hours' south of Bagan is the charming village of Salay, with ancient temples and monasteries overlooked by most tourists. Stay an extra night in Bagan to adventure off-beat and discover what real Myanmar countryside feels like. We start around 08:30am with a lively rural market visit, learn the process of making tamarind flake candies, and visit at the historic Yokesone Monastery, famed for intricate woodcarvings. Continue on to the home of U Ba Gyi, the wealthy merchant behind the construction of this impressive teak monastery, which dates to 1882. A local picnic lunch will be served at an active working monastery before your drive back to Bagan (1.5 hours).
