Sensitivity to Wildlife

- ➤ We do not offer excursions and attractions that involve the captivity of wildlife. Instead, we provide activities and excursions that offer clients the opportunity to experience and learn about animals in their natural habitats, where they can thrive without confinement or exploitation. Our primary focus is on providing experiences that prioritize the welfare and conservation of animals. Our excursions are designed to observe animals in their natural habitat while respecting their space and behavior without interference.
- > We have strict Animal and Wildlife policy in place to prohibit any activities that exploit or harm animals for entertainment or performances that cause distress.
- ➤ We ensure that all our excursions are led by experienced guides who are well-versed in animal behavior, ensuring safe and respectful encounters.

Sensitivity to cultural heritage

- ➤ We intend to promote excursions and activities that directly involve and support local communities. Our approach includes supporting local products, traditional crafts, locally sourced food production, and visiting local projects and attractions to contribute to the growth of the community.
- ➤ We hold deep respect for local traditions, and as part of this commitment, we ensure that our activities and excursions do not cause harm to local people, animals, communities, or the environment.
- > We ensure that all our excursions are led by experienced guides who prioritize safety and respect for the area, its people, and its cultural heritage.

Sensitivity to natural heritage
