



Yangon Heritage Walk and High Tea at Strand Hotel

Discover the highlights of downtown Yangon with some of Asia's most impressive examples of late 19th and early 20th century architecture.

On this heritage walk you go back in time to discover these beautifully constructed colonial monuments, some of which have been neglected, while others have been purposefully restored. Stop off at the abandoned Ministers' Building, formerly known as The Secretariat, where the 'Father of the Nation', General Aung San. started the path to independence. Built in 1889, this impressive building and its gardens take up a whole block in the downtown area. After the walk, stop for high tea and refreshments at the famous Victorian-era Strand Hotel that looks out onto the Yangon River.
